VocaBo - Giovanni Boccaccio's lexicon online: the vocabulary of the arts”	<p><u>THEME TO BE DEVELOPED</u></p> <p>The research area of the scholarship is that of digital humanities and computer lexicography and lexicology.</p> <p>The general purpose of the work, in its theoretical and applicative components, is the management of lexicographic data on a large scale, placing Boccaccio's vocabulary in the Italian linguistic tradition; the project also intends to enhance the cultural heritage of the Italian literary and linguistic tradition through one of its greatest authors, and intends to do so through the tools of the most up-to-date digital lexicographic science. It therefore requires an adequate and</p>	

	<p>systematic theoretical and historical-critical study, in addition to lexicographical practicality.</p> <p>The research activity to be carried out at the foreign institution will consist in the drafting of a part of the lexicographical entries, accompanied by an adequate theoretical study.</p>

Selection mode	<p>The selection is based on qualifications and exams (written test and interview). The competition takes place face-to-face.</p> <p>The written test consists in carrying out a track chosen from two or more proposals for each curriculum.</p> <p>In the case of the RESTRICTED PEGASO scholarship, the written test consists in carrying out a track consistent with the theme of the project.</p> <p>In the interview, which will take place in Italian, the candidate will be asked to discuss the doctoral research project with the commission, and relevant topics and aspects of the discipline in which the research project falls will be addressed and discussed.</p> <p>For candidates who do not possess the B2 English language certification, the Commission will verify their knowledge of the English language at level B2.</p>
