MapS - Mapping Sienese Sociability in Early Modernity (XVI-XVIII Century)	The research project intends to study the functioning of the Sienese academies in order to reconstruct the pattern of relationships between intellectuals between the 16th and early 18th centuries. Particular attention will be paid to the heritage of manuscripts and printed books relating to the academies preserved in the libraries and archives of Siena, investigated with the aid of technologies connected to digital humanities: diaries and minutes of meetings, exchanges of letters, collective publications which represented a model that has spread throughout Europe. The stay at the Faculty of Languages of the Jagiellonian University of Krakow (Poland) will allow the doctoral student to collaborate on the project "DiHeLib - European Heritage in the Jagiellonian Library: Digital Authoring of the Berlin Collections", aimed at valorising a significant archival fund of a literary and scientific nature. The project also includes a collaboration with the CISS-International Center for Studies on the Seventeenth Century of the University for Foreigners of

	be in possession of one of the following qualifications a) specialist degree obtained pursuant to ministerial decree 509/1999; b) master's degree obtained pursuant to ministerial decree 270/2004; c) degree obtained in accordance with previous educational systems, the legal course of which lasts at least four years; d) similar academic qualification obtained abroad. Even those who do not possess the required qualification at the time of the deadline for the announcement can apply to participate in the doctoral admission competition. 	In addition to the requirements indicated above, candidates for these scholarships must::
	 be aged no more than 35 years at the time of the application to participate in the doctoral competition; demonstrate that you have adequate knowledge of the English language (at least equivalent to level B2).

Selection mode	The selection is based on qualifications and exams (written test and interview). The competition takes place in person.
	The written test consists of completing a track chosen from two or more proposals for each curriculum.
	In the case of the PEGASO RESTRICTED grant, the written test consists of carrying out an outline consistent with the theme of the project.
	In the interview, which will take place in Italian, the candidate will be asked to discuss the doctoral research project with the commission, and relevant themes and aspects of the discipline in which the research project falls will be addressed and discussed.
	For candidates not in possession of the B2 English language certification, the knowledge of the B2 level English language will be verified by the Commission.
