Theo Marinis is Professor of Multilingualism at the University of Konstanz and at the University of Reading and Director of the <u>Centre for Multilingualism</u> at the University of Konstanz. His research focuses on language acquisition and processing across populations of monolingual and multilingual children with typical development as well as children with atypical language development, such as children with Developmental Language Disorders and children with Autism Spectrum Disorders. He conducts fundamental and applied research across the disciplines of linguistics, education, and speech & language pathology. He was part of the COST Action ISO804 <u>'Language Impairment in a Multilingual Society: Linguistic Patterns and the Road to Assessment'</u> and led the development of the <u>LITMUS Sentence Repetition tasks</u> for multilingual children across a large range of languages. He is currently leading the EU project <u>'The Multilingual Mind'</u> that provides multi-disciplinary training on multilingualism to early stage researchers in Europe.
