Richard Rossner was a co-founder of Eaquals (an international non-profit association that works to raise the quality of language education worldwide by providing practical guidance and support for teaching organisations and teachers) and part-time executive director from 2006 to 2012. He later became a Board Member and was Executive Director of Eaquals from 2006 to 2011 and Chair from 2014 to 2016.

He is also a co-author of the European Profiling Grid and the Eaquals Framework for Language Teacher Training and Development.

Previously he served as Chief Executive of the Bell Educational Trust for 6 years, following various other management roles in Bell, which he joined in 1984. Prior to that he had served for 6 years as editor of ELT Journal. Richard continues to work for Eaquals as an inspector and consultant.

He represents Eaquals and the UK as an expert on ISO working groups in the field of education and training, and is a member of the Council of Europe's coordinating group on the linguistic integration of adult migrants.
